Dear Vendor:

Thank you for your interest in being a Native American Arts and Crafts vendor at the 2017 NATIVE Project Open House. The Event is taking place Friday, May 26, 2016 from 12:00 PM – 3:00 PM. Spaces are limited; first come, first served, and only completed forms accepted will have a reserved vendor table.

Vendors must donate a raffle item valued at \$50 or more. We'll be raffling these items off throughout the day to Open House attendees. With your item, please include a business card or name and contact information, along with any description of the item. We'll be sure to thank and acknowledge your donation.

The table size is approximately 5 x 2.5 feet. Table sizes and power availability is not guaranteed. Bring your own power/extension cord. All Vendor tables will be indoor, with plenty of lighting. Food vendors will not be allowed. One table per person/organization.

Vendor setup will be available only during the times of **9:00 AM – 11:00 AM**. Take down must be completed before **4:00 PM**. The NATIVE Project parking lot will be sectioned off, so please prepare to park on the street and carry your items in; we will not have staff available to unload/load.

The Indian Arts and Crafts Act of 1990 (P.L. 101-644) is a truth-in-advertising law that prohibits misrepresentation in marketing of Indian arts and crafts products within the United States. It is illegal to offer or display for sale, or sell any art or craft product in a manner that falsely suggests it is Indian produced, an Indian product, or the product of a particular Indian or Indian Tribe or Indian arts and crafts organization, resident within the United States.

Under the Act, an Indian is defined as a member of any federally or officially State recognized Indian Tribe, or an individual certified as an Indian artisan by an Indian Tribe.
